

Monday 9th December 2025 Christmas Wines

Welcome drink: Langlois-Chateau 'L' Extra par Langlois' Crémant de Loire Brut 12.5%. A sparkler from the famous Bollinger stable. A fizz with a delicious flavour. Fresh and aromatic. A 5-star rated blend of Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay.

Starter: Val de Loire Chardonnay, Famille Bougriet 2023 - a nice dry wine with delicate buttery & nutty aromas leaving velvety notes in the mouth.

Mains White: Honey Drop Chenin Blanc 2022/3 12.5% alc – made with some of oldest bush-vine Chenin Blanc in Swartland. Expect creamy tropical and peachy notes under rich layers of oak & vanilla.

Mains Red: Concha y Toro Marcelo Limari Pinot Noir 2022 15.5% alc. The Limari Valley in Chile has ideal conditions for Pinot Noir. This blend of barrel & tank has lovely black cherry fruit and a pretty, silky palate.

Cheese: Pagos del Rey 409 Ribera del Douro 2021 14.5% alc. Aged in oak for 409 days. Discover juicy dark fruit flavours of the Tempranillo grape balanced by complex notes of toasted spices, dark chocolate, walnut & tobacco.

Dessert: Leyrissat Monbazillac 12.5% alc . Golden in colour, with intense notes of honey, blossom & marmalade on the nose & concentrated flavours of honey, blossom & marmalade on the nose & concentrated flavours of honey & marmalade on the palate.
