1.	2023 Château Thieuley Blanc A blend of semillon, sauvignon blanc and sauvignon gris. Made by the Courselle family in the Entre-Deux-Mers	The Wine Society
2.	2022 A de Château d'Arche Citrus and exotic fruit. A blend of 85% semillon and 15% sauvignon blanc from the vineyards of a Sauternes property ripe grapes are embellished with partial barrel ageing.	The Wine Society
3.	2020 Château de la Grave 'Caractère', Côtes de Bourg A blend of 80% merlot and 20% cabernet sauvignon. Aged for 12 months in two and three-year-old barrels. Concentrated but elegant dark plummy fruit.	The Wine Society
4.	2020 Château de Pitray, 'Pitray' Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux 'Pitray' is a celebration of this estate's best parcels of Merlot, blended with just 10% Cabernet Franc. Aged in oak barrels, 38% of which are new. Plush fruit, dried fig and spice underpinned by velvety tannins.	Liberty Wines
5.	2018 Chateau Cissac, Haut Medoc Cru Bourgeois Superieur Cabernet Sauvignon blended with some Merot, Petit Verdot and a touch of Malbec. Vibrant and elegant ripe fruit combined with a little new oak.	The Wine Society
6.	Ulysse Cazabonne, Sauternes (3rd release) Beautiful quality Sauternes. Principally Semillon with a splash of Sauvignon Blanc. Who makes this? It's a secret!	The Wine Society
