1. Bodegas Vinatigo, Islas Canarias, Tenerife Marmajuelo 2022
Grown in The Canary Islands, marmajuelo is an indigenous grape variety with aromatic, tropical notes and divine minerality.
2. Pinot Bianco, Sudtirol-Alto Adige. Hofstatter 2023
An elegant, understated white wine with a deliciously inviting white peach and herby aroma
3. Serbal Blanc Blend 2024
Grown in the high mountain vineyards at Tupungato, Mendoza a smashing blend of chardonnay, viognier and sauvignon Blanc.
4. Pinot Nero, Les Cretes 2020
Les Cretes is a prestigious and significant winery located high in the Valle d'Aosta, the smallest region in Italy.
5. Etna Rosso, Tascante Ghiaia Nera 2022
Made from the indigenous nerello mascalese grape this age worthy red is akin to both pinot noir and nebbiolo.
6. Aniello 006 Malbec 2022
A refreshing malbec due to its lovely high balanced acidity. A lunchtime wine?
