Chateau de L'Aulee Brut Classic Cremant de Loire.

“From chenin blanc grapes by a winemaker who worked for Bollinger for 15 years. Reminiscent of pears, apples and toasted walnuts. “Lovely” according to Victoria Moore in The Telegraph.”

For the starter

The Wine Society's White French Burgundy.

“A fine, dry white from southern Burgundy. Ripe and round, with flavours of apple and stone fruit, a hint of citrus and a streak of minerality.”

Mains red 1

Domare Barbera Piemonte 2023.

“Abundant cherry fruit and freshness. Midweight, silky with gentle tannins.”

Mains red 2

Black St Peter Old Vine Zinfandel.

“Awesomely rich and weighty, spicy black Zinfandel. From sunny Lodi, California's hot spot for top notch Zinfandel.”

Chateau Pech La Calevie 2022 Monbazillac.

“Glorious, succulent and peachy, from the Dordogne made in the style of a Sauternes. Fully sweet but retaining delicacy and freshness.”
